ECOQUEST BOARD CHANGES

The Board of EcoQuest Limited (ASX: ECQ) - the Australian company on the verge of a worldwide launch of a 90% biodegradable nappy – has announced changes to its Board, following the resignation of EcoQuest's Chairman, Mr Leon Davies, after two years on the Board.

EcoQuest Independent Director, leading environmental scientist Ms Sylvia Tulloch, has been appointed Interim Chairman whilst discussions with candidate replacements for Mr Davies are undertaken.

"Since I joined the EcoQuest Board as Chairman two years ago, I have seen the Company develop into a respected part of the cleantech community, as we worked to develop the corporate sustainability practices to match our commitment to developing and applying the latest technologies to create products with improved environmental benefits," Mr Davies said.

"Our focus has to remain maintaining excellent consumer performance. As EcoQuest's market is global, it is an appropriate time for me to step back as Chairman," he said.

"I always have been, and will continue to be, a firm believer in the Company's mission - a future where disposable personal products finish up as compost instead of landfill."

"On behalf of the Board and shareholders, our thanks go to Mr Davies for his contribution to the Company. We all wish him well for the future and congratulate him on his recent appointment to the Western Force Board," Ms Tulloch said.

"His strong leadership and extensive business skills have assisted EcoQuest get to where it is today – only three months away from first commercial production of its unique, environmentally-friendly range of nappies."

EcoQuest Limited is a globally focused clean technology business based in Perth Western Australia, listed on the Australian Stock Exchange (ASX ticker ECQ) and traded on the German Third Market.

EcoQuest is focused on developing and applying the latest technologies to create products with improved environmental benefits, but still maintaining excellent consumer performance.

The first product in the EcoQuest range is a 90% biodegradable nappy designed for composting, which combines all the performance benefits of current market leading nappies with additional benefits for babies and our environment.

EcoQuest nappies have been tested in accordance with Australian Standard AS4736-2006 Biodegradable Plastics. At the conclusion of six months independent scientific testing, the nappies achieved 90% of the maximum theoretical value for biodegradation.

A rigorous program of independent consumer testing of the new nappy with mothers and their babies has now also been completed, with strong results. It has already received strong interest from potential commercial customers throughout the world.

EcoQuest's intellectual property is focused on non-woven disposable products, and products in planning include wipes and incontinence products.
